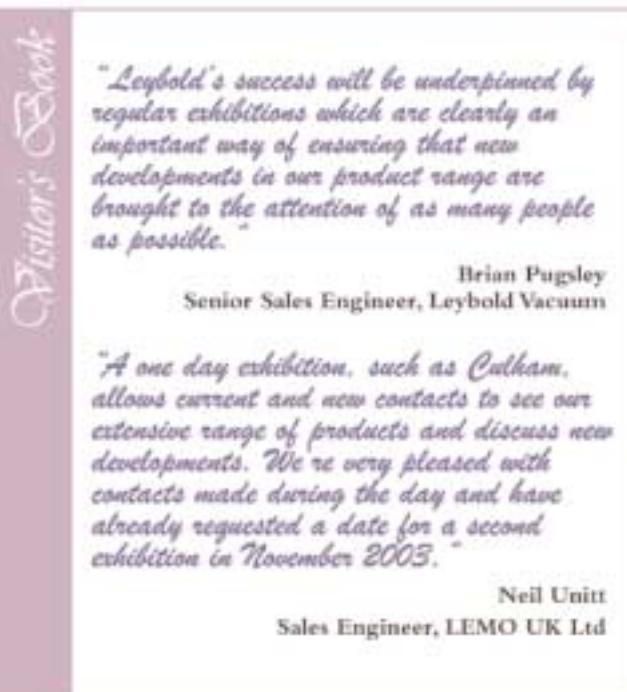
29th January – IMI Norgren/IMI Webber
